The measure has a plain straight sided body with a large curve handle with thumb rest, attached to the body with a large escutcheon. There is a WR Crown verification to the left of the handle and a clear makers mark inside the base. The front of the measure is engraved in large script, 'Gilcomston Brewery 12'.
