The caddy spoon has a scallop-shaped bowl with a plain bordered handle and to the rear of the handle is a small group of engraved initials of a previous owner (see photo) This wonderful piece would have once belonged to a wealthy Georgian Family and used daily in a time when tea drinking was an Art and very expensive.
