These handsome menu holders which are designed as a Royal Naval Crown could also be used to display photographs or business cards or look very nice on display just on their own. This would make a great collectors piece for a menu holder or Naval item collector and it is great to have these in their original box. Hallmarked: Fully hallmarked with Lion for sterling silver.
