This is part of an English dessert service Victorian, mid to late 1800's Possibly "Ridgway". The central "magnificent tazza" has damage, but still not only useable but also extremely decorative. The base colour is a deep ox-blood/maroon and it has been exceptionally finely gilded. The gilding work is of an exceptional standard. There are two left and two right central serving dishes with scallop handles. The surface of the dishes and central pedestal are in relief and decorated accordingly. The central motif in each is that of handpainted spring flowers. Superb display or table settings. To re-affirm the handles of the central tazza are broken, and photographed.
