Description

This late 19th-century oil painting by Swedish artist Carl Johansson (1863-1944) depicts a wintery view with buildings. A prominent peak, almost crystalline, dominates this chilly vista. Towering over an abundance of snow etched by partially buried fences. On either side, the forests appear like stalagmites, flanking the farm with their brightly coloured facades. Johansson was a rebel - a progressive artist influenced by the French Impressionists. Following three years at the formal Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Stockholm, he joined 'the Opponents' and sought to embrace modernity. Here, we see his philosophies in action - applied with texture, feeling and mood. This was observed from life, with boots submerged in the crunch of winter. Signed/dated lower left and framed.
