The top front of the shank bears a flower bud motif and the bowl is shaped to a gentle point. Gwendoline Whicker (1900-66) was a Cornish born Artist, specializing in prints and etchings in her early career and exhibiting regularly at the Royal West Of England. Whicker's work did not receive the acclaim due in her lifetime, despite it's quality and standard, but she is now a sought after artist. This wonderful collector's piece bears the additional Queen's Coronation hallmark and is both practical and decorative. Dimensions below.
