This rug uses the 'Herati' fish design in the main field and ivory central medallion also known as the 'Mina-Khani' floral pattern. Lovely pale pinks and early green dyes have been used to weave a delightful rug. In wonderful condition, professionally washed and supplied with our sturdy anti-slip rug underlay.
