The domed top flame mahogany case is perfect with no scratches or damage, it measures 14 inches high, 9 inches wide and 6 1/2 inches deep. The silvered dial is 6 inches in diameter and in perfect condition. The hands are a beautiful peacock blue. The sides are decorated with traditional Lions head masks with fish scale fret work panels backed by red velvet. Its the most original example you will ever see.
