The brass has been meticulously professionally polished, a winning combination with the cognac leather. The brass is engraved with the military crow's foot mark together with Mk 5 Wide and 54043. They come with a leather case stamped with military marks and 2 1/2 on the lid (wear commensurate with age and use for over 100 years). They are in fully working order and in superb condition. They measure 4 3/4" x 2 1/4" x 4 3/4" tall expanding to 6 1/2" when the sun shades are in use and they are fully opened. The case measures 5 1/2" x 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".
