Both elegantly modelled hounds painted with large underglaze black spots, and 'Disraeli Curls' to their heads, and are stood with their catch of hares. Set upon grassy mound bases, with a 'dash and dot' gilt line to the foot. Length - 23 cm, 9 1/8". Height - 27.5 cm, 10 7/8". Width - 9.5 cm, 3 3/4".
