The lock set to the centre of the large clasp design decoration to match the corners. The sloping front folding forward and the rear section folding back to reveal a superb original fitted interior. Pen and ink compartments to the rear with gilt brass fittings, decoration and ink well tops. The sloping surface with tooled leather, the rear half opening to reveal an internal compartment for storing paper and envelopes. Bears the name for top quality London maker, Betjemann's to the lock. Presented in immaculate condition with a deep shine and original patina. Measures 14" wide x 10" deep closed or 20" deep when open x 4.5" maximum height.
