Made from fine cast bronze set on original lozenge shaped onyx base with a green velvet lining underneath. Origin from USA. Jean Walwyn is an American Impressionist & Modern artist who was born in the 20th Century in the year 1925. This is in our opinion her finest equine sporting works. The Triumph Hurdle is a Grade 1 National Hunt hurdle race in Great Britain which is open to horses aged four years. It is run on the New Course at Cheltenham over a distance of about 2 miles and 1 furlong (2 miles and 179 yards, or 3,382 metres), and during its running there are eight hurdles to be jumped. The race is for juvenile novice hurdlers, and it is scheduled to take place each year during the Cheltenham...

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
