The rounded rectangular bowl engraved with flowers on a finely textured background. The hollow handle with prick-dot borders. The back plain. * from the late 18th to early 19th Century, Birmingham was the centre for the making of "toys": small decorative objects from silver. They were produced in small family businesses and factories throughout Birmingham.
