An 8-day duration, twin fusee mechanism striking the 1/2 hours and hours on a bell engraved 'Jefferson Bruton Street'. A pendulum transportation lock. An enamel dial with fine blued steel hands also signed 'Jefferson Bruton Street'. A locking front bezel and rear door. Circa 1835. Samuel Jefferson of Bruton Street, London worked 1809-1840. A clock is in Windsor Castle and he was clockmaker to the Prince of Wales. Height 8 1/2 " / 22cms Width 6 1/2 " / 17cms Depth 5 " / 12cms.
