Oudin Paris' with brass 'Breguet' hands and subsidiary dials for days of the week and months. An engraved case with the original gilding and a finely proportioned carrying handle. A lift up rear door with sliding shutters to wind and set the hands. An original escapement. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours and 1/2 hours on a bell with an outside striking count wheel. Circa 1860 Charles Oudin worked in Paris from 1804 at Palais Royal until the late 1800's. ?
