This Victorian solid sterling silver butt or peg marker is in an excellent condition. It is clearly hallmarked for Birmingham 1894 with the maker's mark of George Unite. It is a plain rectangle opened via a sprung hinged cover which has a suspension loop. It opens to reveal ten numbered pegs (not marked). The clever design of the peg slots ensure that they don't (all) fall out when it is opened - invariably, some do! It is unusually free from any engravings. The sides show some slight surface abrasions, but nothing that one wouldn't expect from an item of this age.
