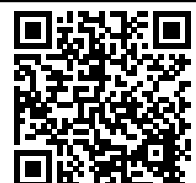
Description

Each spoon has a crest engraved to the top of the handle that looks like a seahorse body with a lions head. All the spoons are fully hallmarked showing the leopards head of the London assay office, the lion passant indicating sterling silver and the date letter 'b' 1817.
