Description

John Frederick Tayler PRWS 1802-1889. Painter of sporting subjects, landscapes with figures and animals (chiefly Scottish) and illustrations of past times, some of them scenes in Waverley Novels; lithographer and etcher. Educated at Eton and Harrow; studied art at Sass's Academy, the RA Schools, in Paris under Horace Vernet and in Rome. Prolific exhibitor from 1839-1889 at RA but principally at OWS where he showed 528 works and was President 1858-1871. Awarded gold medals at the Paris Exhibition of 1855, in Bavaria in 1859 and Vienna 1872. Queen Victoria purchased several of his pictures which are now in the Royal Collection.
