## Description

An elegant antique featherbanded walnut lowboy dating from the late George I or early George II era, with shapely cabriole legs, three oak lined drawers, and a quarter veneered top. The lowboy is veneered in beautifully figured walnut and has a wonderful rich colour. This beautifully proportioned 18th century walnut lowboy is compact in size and, in my opinion, a thing of beauty. It is thought that lowboys were probably made as dressing tables, but they are most commonly used now as side tables. This one has some lovely details, including the gently rounded corners to the top and the delicate feather-banding to the drawers and top. Condition: This little table is in good condition overall, and appears to have been well looked after throughout its life, though of course at around 300 years old there are some signs of wear. There are some marks to the top where it has had things standing on it, and some indented scratch marks (some probably caused by a child), but these just add to its patina. The rest of the lowboy has a few very minor marks and scuffs, but nothing of significance. In terms of damage, there is a small crack to the veneer on the top, and a small area of lo...
