Description

A good landscape watercolour of the Salmon pool on the River Santon, Isle of Man by much sought after Isle of Man artist, William Hoggatt. Signed lower right. Beautifully mounted and framed; the painting having been professionally cleaned. A superb and large example which must be seen to be appreciated. Overall dimensions including frame : 100 cm x 82 cm. Provenance: Kentraugh House, Isle of Man. William Hoggatt (1879 - 1961) was born in Lancaster of a Cumbrian father and Scottish mother. He won a scholarship to the Royal College of Art, however did not take it up and became an apprentice of a local stained glass makers. William Hoggatt continued his studies at the school of art in Lancaster's Storey Institute. Aided by one of the Storeys, William went onto study at the Academie Julian in Paris, 1901 - 05. William met his future wife, Dazine, whilst working on a commission at the Tate Gallery. Both parents opposed their intended marriage, so William and Dazine eloped to the Isle of Man in 1907. After moving to the Isle of Man, William Hoggatt painted mainly Manx subjects, many of which were of scenes within walking distance of his home in Port Erin. William Hoggatt...
