This fine Portrait of Doña Isabel de Porcel is an oil-on-canvas painting after the famous Spanish painter Francisco Goya who originally first painted the study around 1805. - ABOUT ARTIST GOYA Francisco José de Goya y Lucientes was a Spanish romantic painter and printmaker. He is considered the most important Spanish artist of the late 18th and early 19th centuries and throughout his long career was a commentator and chronicler of his era. - BORN: 30 March 1746, Fuendetodos, Spain DIED: 16 April 1828, Bordeaux, France PERIODS: Romanticism, Rococo FULL NAME: Francisco José de Goya y Lucientes NATIONALITY: Spanish CHILDREN: Francisco Javier Goya Bayeu. - This later portrait dating around the mid 20th century, is a good copy after the original, depicting 'Isabel Lobo Velasco de Porcel', who was born at Ronda around 1780 and was the second wife of Antonio Porcel. - Isabel's husband was 25 years older than she; they met when she was 20 years old. Antonio Porcel was a liberal and associate of Manuel Godoy, Prince of Peace, who was a friend of Gaspar Melchor de Jovellanos, who in turn brought him in contact with Goya, who lived nearby.
