Yorkshire chairs are known for the broad arms and the emphasis on the bold hand grips. The yew on the hoops, splats, and arms are full of life, the flowing figuring and pips in the grain is so pleasing to the eye. The seats made of the usual solid elm, the legs, and stretchers in solid yew wood. Imagine these exceptional Victorian Yew Broad Arm Windsor chairs in your home and how much pleasure you will get by owning them. I always find Windsor chairs interesting as these were made for hard working people for either estate farmhouses or more modest cottages.
