It has a triangular panel seat raised on 2 upright supports and three legs united by shaped stretchers. Like all antiques there are some imperfections however this is a solid chair with no wobbles or creaks. This Old Saxon style chair is a fantastic shape and a great colour that will enhance any corner it is placed. When an item is described as being "in the manner of John Starkey," it means that the piece was created in a style or design reminiscent of the work associated with John Starkey, John Starkey, an English artist and craftsman, is known for his work in furniture design and woodworking. He created a reproduction of the "Old Saxon Chair" His work reflects the Victorian interest in Tudor and Elizabethan styles, with high-quality reproductions often mistaken for original pieces of early furniture.
