Engraved to the rim in French for 'Ecuelle appartenant a la confrerie du Mont Carmel et pour queter en l'honneur de la sainte Vierge 1809' (Bowl belonging to the brotherhood of Mount Carmel and for begging in honor of the Blessed Virgin 1809). This item is of good used condition with some surface marking and dimples to the bowl and wear to the silvered base. An unusual and historically interesting piece. Weight approx 412g.
