Description

Early 19th century mahogany apothecary cabinet, the interior with five bays lined compartments above a bank of five drawers one of which is deep and divided, another shallower and lined with bays compartments and three small drawers with sliding wooden covers. All fitted with original turned ivory knobs, all enclosed by a pair of hinged doors each containing nine bays lined compartments. The rear with a concealed sliding panel enclosing four bays lined compartments containing a number of original square glass bottles and a collection of miscellaneous medicine bottles of various dates and origins. The exterior faded to a mellow golden colour and with a brass swan's-neck carrying handle and inset brass escutcheons.
