Two pieces of Art Deco Beswick. The jug designed in 1933 by Mr Symcox. The shape number 173 impressed to the base with a production run of 20 years. The vase designed in 1934 and again by Mr Symcox. The shape number 154 impressed to the base with a short production run of 6 years. Mr Symcox worked for Beswick between 1933 and 1942 as a freelance sculptor. His design of these two pieces fully embraced the Art Deco style, with the fabulous hand painted stylised trees in colours of bold purple, yellow, teal and brown.
