Description

Joseph Saer was working in Perpoole Lane, London between 1687 – 1704. The flat top hood with a moulded cornice, blind fretwork frieze and glazed side windows, encasing the 28cm square brass and silvered dial, centered with a subsidiary second dial and date aperture. The chapter ring signed with the makers name, enclosing the two train, four pillar movement striking on a saucer bell. The figured elm and walnut case with a conforming lower board, upon a plinth base, 207cm high, with two weights and pendulum. Provenance: Property of 7th Baron Harlech, The Lord Harlech, Glyn & Brogyntyn. Condition report. General light tarnishing to the clock dial. This clock has been in storage for decades and is in remarkably good order. The movement will be given a full service and with that comes a 2-year guarantee.
