Sits on a double series opaque twist stem consisting of a pair of 9-ply spiral bands outside a pair of multiply corkscrews. Conical foot. A rare twist and a rare bowl combination. **Date & Origin** England, c1760. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 14.8cm Bowl diameter: 5.8cm Foot diameter: 7.2cm. **Historical Context** George III, the third Hanoverian monarch, became king in 1760 and was the first of his line to use English as his first language.
