This model registration number is for Holland and Sons, the eminent 19th century makers of fine quality chairs and this chair retains the original brass and beaded casters on fluted and turned legs to front and raked back legs with original casters also. The arm supports are fluted and turned also. . The casters are stamped Clarke and Timmins a company with its origins in Birmingham in the 1760s and as well regarded for casters and locks as Cope & Collison. In 1897 the two companies merged and in 1910 the company changed its name to Cope & Timmins London Ltd. . Casters made by this firm are found on fine quality chairs made by Holland & Sons, Gillow and Howard & Sons. . The chair is upholstered in a thick dusky plum velvet which is in good condition throughout with no tears or noticeable wear or marks. The chair is extremely comfortable and robust. This is a beautiful example, very original and in good order with only minor marks and dings consistent with age and careful us...
