Original gilded finish to the movement, with the maker's name stamped to the top; glass ink bottle to the side. Moulded waist with chart drawer below, complete with double section of spare charts. Fully serviced in working order. Measures 14.5" wide x 8.5" deep x 9" high. *Dolland of London, barometer, scientific instrument maker and Optician to William IV & Queen Victoria.
