Description

A small but rare mid 18thc map of Hertfordshire, England by Emanuel Bowen (royal geographer) and printed for Thomas Kitchin of London. The main title, top left, states that "Hartfordshire" is divided into Hundreds and that the map shows the county and market towns with historical extracts on produce, trade and manufacture. The extracts cover Hartford, St Albans, Ware, Bishops Stortford, Hitchin and Abbots Langley, noted for the birth of Pope Adrian IV. There is also a Key with explanations for symbols used on the map. The map is in excellent antique condition. No damage. It has not been bleached.

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
