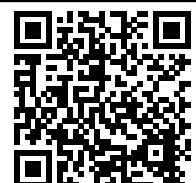
Description

This most unusual English late 19th century scratch built folk art model is of a very pleasing and elegant 19th century sailing boat. It is made mainly from yew wood with some elements in a lighter timber. The hull is hand carved from a single piece and has planked detailing. The boat is fully rigged with hand stitched sails and a hinged rudder. It has good detail on the deck and interior. It is displayed on a matching fitted turned yew wood stand.
