The arched top section has four, lovely original astragal glazed doors with flat columns to either side. Even the twelve adjustable pine shelves are still in the original pinky Georgian paint finish. The base of this Cumbrian late 18th century antique apothecary cabinet has forty original drawers with original hand painted and gilt labels for their remedy contents.
