A fabulous and unusual antique sapphire ring. The large sapphire in the centre – certified as natural, unheated and originating from Ceylon (Sri Lanka) – is a deep blue with a bright internal glow. The stone is secured in a silver collet with four sets of double-claws with angular detailing in the gallery, leading to a slender 18k yellow gold shank. A fantastic and wholly unique piece of jewellery. Accompanied by a report from Gemmological Certification Services (GCS) stating the sapphire shows no indication of heating, and is Sri Lankan (Ceylon) in origin. Cut – Pear cabochon. Colour – Blue. Clarity – SI. Carat – 15.33. Circa – 1905. Size – Q (UK) or 8 (US). Complimentary sizing is available, can go up or down. Measurements – The sapphire is 16.3 x 13.5mm. Sits 7.9mm from the finger. Metal – 18k yellow gold. The sapphire is in a silver collet. Tested.
