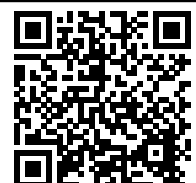
Antique Edwardian quality mahogany inlaid dressing table having a shield shaped adjustable mirror with scroll shaped supports above two small figured mahogany bow fronted drawers crossbanded in satinwood with ornate pretty oval brass handles. The shaped bow fronted quality figured mahogany top is also crossbanded in satinwood above two long and two short figured mahogany drawers also crossbanded in attractive satinwood with original ornate brass handles standing on square tapering mahogany legs with satinwood inlaid stringing with original brass castors. An elegant Edwardian example which boasts a marvellous colour. James Shoolbred & Co or also known as Jas Shoolbred was established in the 1820's as a draper's shop, at Tottenham Court Road, London. The company first began supplying textiles to the furniture trade. By the 1860's, the company began designing, manufacturing and selling its own high quality antique furniture in their thriving and fashionable furniture shop. By the 1880's, Jas Shoolbred had expanded to such an extent that the business had to move to larger premises, becoming one of the first large department stores in London, who would supply quality antiques.

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
