The top consists of a central pierced copper panel with symbolic images of snakes, vine leaves and mythological creatures inset into the table top, the outer wooden top profusely carved with peacocks and foliate decoration. This leading down to an octagonal base consisting of superbly carved peacock and foliate decoration, the peacock being the national bird of India and is a symbol of grace, joy, beauty and love. The table top can be removed from the base and the base can be folded for easy storage and transportation.
