Description

Late 17th century figured walnut cabinet on later 19th century stand. The top cabinet section is all period except for the back which is a later replacement. The cabinet has a pair of beautifully figured walnut doors, the doors with a wide feather banding and cross banded in straight grain walnut. All the cornice and mouldings are all cross grain walnut. The cabinet has a single fixed shelf in the middle. The top section lifts off the base section for moving. The base has been made in the late 19th century but to an exceptionally high standard as can be seen in the pictures. The whole piece is a lovely colour and would make an ideal drinks cabinet in a dining room (which was exactly its use when I purchased it privately from a large country house).
