Description

An early French carriage clock by Lamy & Lacroix of Mores (Chemin de Mores is about 30 miles North-West of Paris), signed to the dial and engraved on the backplate. The enamelled dial has decorative steel hands and roman numerals. The original 8-day movement strikes hours and half-hours on a bell and has an outside count-wheel. The lovely case is cast with flowers, leaves and scrolls. Large bevelled glass panels to 5-sides. Dimensions: Height: 17 cm (handle up). Width: 10 cm Depth: 8.5 cm Date: c.1860
