The diamond are old European cuts, eight-cuts and rose cuts. Colour – The diamonds are F to G. Clarity – The diamond are SI1 to SI2; all are clean to the naked eye. Carat – The opal is approximately 20.00 carat; the diamond weight is approximately 0.97 carat. There are a total of 39 diamonds. Circa – 1940. Provenance – French. Measurements – The opal is approximately is 22.97 x 17.90mm. From the top of the bale to the bottom of the opal is 70.2mm Metal – 18k white gold. French hallmarks.
