This exceptional small round dial London longcase clock, retailed by Bentley and Beck of the Royal Exchange London . The eight day five pillar movement with shaped plates, strikes on the hour on a bell, with a convex painted dial, roman numerals and blue steel hands, with the makers name Bentley and Beck Royal exchange London to the dial , the clock has a silent and strike facility to the dial . The movement stamped Handley and Moore this is stamped to the front plate , convex glass with inner and outer brass bezels complete with its original brass cased weights , with substantial wood rod pedulum with brass bob. The lancet top curl mahogany case with round fretted hood sides panels, quater round coloumns, brass inlays with solid ebony mouldings by a exceptional cabinet maker of his day . The clock has taken on a superb deep patination including the weights and pedulum which has been created over the 200 plus years with original hood, door and winding keys.
