Description

Exceptional English George III sterling silver coffee pot with domed hinged lid over a pear shaped baluster body that is resting on a circular domed spreading foot. Splendid Rococo repoussage of flowers, scrolls and foliage. The swan neck spout is decorated with applied chased leaf design; the same motif is repeated on the lid. The double C scroll handle is made of walnut that has lovely warm patina and beautiful grain. The coffeepot has two asymmetric cartouches that are enclosed in floral rocaille borders; one cartouches is initialled "M", the other is vacant. Hallmarked for London, 1767. 1126 g / 36.2 t oz 30 cm tall 13 cm across at widest point 11 cm base diameter 23 cm from spout to handle Excellent antique condition. Shallow indent underneath the initial; shallow depression to the right and underneath the spout; shallow depression underneath and to the left of the vacant cartouche; small dings to the very base the baluster body; small split to the top of the spout; tiny hole to the finial.
