Crafted from walnut, a wood which was highly prized during the 18th century for its exceptional colour variation and grain patterns, this chest boasts two smaller drawers stacked above three larger ones, known as a 2-over-3 configuration, providing ample storage space. The top of the chest and the three lower, larger drawers feature crossbanding and geometric motifs which involves applying an inlay of contrasting wood. The drawers feature crossbanding which frames the beautiful herringbone inlays which are made up by arranging pieces of veneer or inlay in a zigzag pattern, resem...
