They feature hand painted oval plaques depicting cherubs in clouds surrounded by floral drapes with gilt high-lights and ormolu leaf cast mounts and ribbon tied crestings. They are each numbered 130 -170 and signed with the black Sevres mark on the reverse. There is no mistaking their unique quality and design and they will soon instantly enhance the style of one special room in your home. It is from Chantilly that a cadre of workers migrated to the Chateau de Vincennes near Paris to form a larger porcelain manufactory in 1738. French King Louis XV, perhaps inspired by his rumoured relationship with mistress Madame de Po...

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
