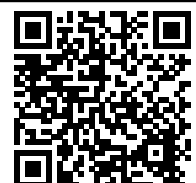

Good clear hallmarks: Ebenezer Coker, London, dated 1739. Dimensions: Length: 7.8 inches (20 cm). Weight: 74 g. We have an almost identical Silver Berry Spoon, as close to 'a pair' as possible. Hallmarked the same year (1739) but with makers stamp for Jesse McFanan.
