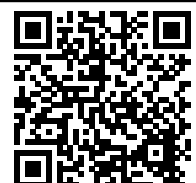
A good George II hallmarked silver-gilt Berry Spoon with embossed fruit decoration and frilled edges. The bowl is silver gilt. The handle bears a 'Green Man' mask and a monogrammed 'S'. Good clear hallmarks: Jesse McFanan (female silversmith), London, dated 1739. Dimensions: Length: 7.8 inches (20 cm). Weight: 74 g. We have an almost identical Silver Berry Spoon, as close to 'a pair' as possible. Hallmarked the same year but made by Ebenezer Coker.
