## Description

Late 18th.c. Dutch marquetry display cabinet c.1790. Shallow upper cabinet, glazed at the front and sides, with a wide single door and fitted inside with three shaped shelves (internal depth 7"). Over a deeper base, also glazed, with two doors and a single shaped shelf (internal depth 8¾"). Walnut veneers with extensive floral marquetry inlays. Raised pediment and arched top glazed panels to the top cabinet, flared mouldings to the upper and lower edges of both cabinets. Raised on tapering square legs joined with a shaped stretcher, all inlaid to match, and turned bun feet. Original velvet lining fabric to the interior, note also the plate grooves at the back edges of the shelves. Attractive period gilded and pieced escutcheons to the keyholes. Some typical old wear and repairs to the veneers, otherwise excellent colour and condition, cleaned and waxed in our workshops. Keys supplied. Dimensions: Width 45½" Height 75" Depth 12"
