This exceptional and rare antique sterling silver mustard pot has a cylindrical form. The body of the mustard pot is embellished with pierced vertical pale and conjoined arch decoration, accented with lozenge motifs, all in the desirable architectural style. The rim of the mustard pot is ornamented with a plain applied moulded border. This antique mustard pot retains the original hallmarked hinged cover surmounted with an impressive lobed thumbpiece. This fine example of antique silverware is fitted with a plain scrolling handle. The mustard pot is fitted with a removable blue glass liner. This Edwardian mustard pot is supplied with an associated spoon, crafted by Peter, Ann & William Bateman in 1802. The mustard pot was crafted by the collectable and renowned silversmith Omar Ramsden and bears the engraving 'G.W. Burrows, Craftsman, Me Fecit' to the underside.
