Glazed view window set in a cast engine turned bezel. Bears the makers name for Dixey, 3 New Bond St, London to the dial, a highly regarded maker of fine instruments and optician to Queen Victoria. Presented in excellent original unrestored condition and in full working order. Measures 5" diameter x 2.25" deep x 6" high including hanging loop.
