A good early 18th Cent walnut London longcase clock by William Botwell, London. He is listed as working there from 1694 to 1727. The case is in nicely figured burr walnut with herringbone inlay. The good quality 8 day movement strikes the hours on a bell. It has a very smart brass dial with gilt spandrels and silvered chapter ring. It has a subsidiary seconds dial and date indicator. The clock has also retained its original brass cased weights. The case is in good condition and is a nice colour, it does however have the expected signs of age and use. The movement is in good working order and keeping good time. It looks to have been recently serviced and new gut lines fitted. Free local delivery and set-up (60mils), national and international delivery arranged at cost. There is a label in the door indicating that this clock was previously sold by Witney Antiques who were regular exhibitors at all the prestigious London fairs including the Grosvenor House Antique Fair.
