A beautiful oak stationery cabinet dating from the early 20th Century. It has a lovely warm patina with ornate brass corner pieces and a brass shield shaped escutcheon. The front is connected to the top so when the front opens downwards the top also opens at the same time. The front reveals a series of racks for holding papers and letters and the top has a pen tray, a glass ink pot, stamp slope and a couple of other sections. The front edge is stamped with a patent number "Rd.186068". It is in good condition for its age. There are a few small knocks and marks around the outside, general signs of age and use but nothing detrimental. There is a small piece of brass missing from one corner and it would have originally had carrying handles on the side but the box still displays well. We do not have a key. It has been lightly cleaned and polished and is ready for use. The best description comes from the photos so please look at them all carefully and if you have any questions just ask.
